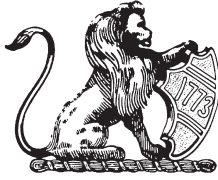


Directions



The Red Lion Inn is located on Main Street Stockbridge at the corner of U.S. Route 7 and Mass. Route 102. The Inn is approximately two and a half hours north of New York City and two hours west of Boston.

From New York City :

(Approximately 2.5 to 3 hours)

Take the Taconic State Parkway north to Claverack

Follow Rte. 23 east into Massachusetts .

Turn left on Rte. 7 North in Great Barrington.

Continue on Rte. 7 for six miles to Stockbridge.

The Inn is on the right, at the junction of Rte 102.

From Boston :

(Approximately 2 hours)

Follow Mass Pike (I-90) West to Exit 2 in Lee.

Turn left onto Rte. 20, and immediately bear right onto Rte. 102.

Proceed west on Rte. 102 for about five miles to Stockbridge. The Inn is on the left.

From Hartford :

(Approximately 1.5 hours)

Follow I-91 North to Exit 14

Take Mass Pike (I-90) West to Exit 2 in Lee

Turn left onto Rte. 20, and immediately bear right onto Rte. 102

Proceed west on Rte. 102 for about five miles to Stockbridge. The Inn is on the left

From Albany :

(Approximately 1 hour)

Follow Interstate 90 East, which becomes a toll section of the NY State Thruway.

Take Exit B3 (Canaan).

Follow Rte. 22 South for approx. 1 mile

Turn left on Rte. 102.

Continue east on Rte. 102 for seven miles to Stockbridge.

The Inn is on the right at the junction of Rte. 7

From Long Island :

(Approximately 3.5 to 4 hours)

Throgs Neck Bridge to Interstate 95 North

Interstate 287 Northwest

Interstate 684 North until it ends.

Continue on Rte. 22 North to Hillsdale.

Follow Rte. 23 east into Massachusetts .

Turn left on Rte. 7 North in Great Barrington.

Continue on Rte. 7 for six miles to Stockbridge.

The Inn is on the right, at the junction of Rte 102.

From New Jersey :

(Approximately 3.5 to 5 hours)

Take I-287 or the Garden State Parkway north to the NYS Thruway.

Take Interstate 84 East to the Taconic State Parkway .

Follow the TSP North to Claverack.

Take Rte. 23 east into Massachusetts .

Turn left on Rte. 7 in Great Barrington.

Continue north on Rte. 7 for six miles to Stockbridge.

The Inn is on the right, at the junction of Rte 102.
