# 8 Beautiful Shabby-Chic Hotels Around the World

With their mismatched accents and another-era warmth, these interiors have us staring

The aesthetic has had a name (“shabby chic”) since the 1980s—thanks to *The World Of Interiors*. ## RED LION INN, MASSACHUSETTS

This historic inn in Stockbridge, Massachusetts, has roomed (and boarded) travelers in the Berkshires since 1773. There are 125 rooms between the main house and the additional houses: antique-decorated accommodations with an abundance of character and chintz.
